14. Highways, Footpaths, Cycleways & Bridleways - Swansea Council

a) Hatched Area or Bollards Required around the Defibrillator, Llangyfelach Church Hall

The Clerk contacted Swansea Council as instructed. Swansea Council shall contact Councillors P Crayford & P Gibson directly regarding the site meeting. The Clerk has sent a chaser email.

15. Playground at Llysgwyn / Bryn Glas, Llangyfelach

The Chair of Council is awaiting a meeting on site with an Officer of Swansea Council.

16. Playground at Fairview Road - Community Budget Capital - Play

17. Defibrillator at Junction of Heol Pentre Felen & Bryn Hedydd

Heartbeat Trust UK remain in discussions with Swansea Council regarding relevant permissions for the installation of this defibrillator. A bollard may be required either side of the defibrillator. A letter of thanks has been delivered to Mr & Mrs Ellis of 10 Clos Waun Wen, Llangyfelach for giving permission for the defibrillator to be fixed to their wall.

Recommended that:

1) The update be noted.

18. Defibrillators within the Llangyfelach Community Council Area

Discussions between the Council, Heartbeat Trust UK and other relevant parties are continuing.

a) Griffiths Waste Management, Bryntywod

Councillor Phil Crayford has contacted Griffiths Waste Management about making their defibrillator available to the public. Discussions have been favourable, and Heartbeat Trust UK are now in direct communication with them.

b) Defibrillator at Llangyfelach Church Hall

Heartbeat Trust UK have proposed that this defibrillator be protected and placed within the Heartbeat Trust UK insurance & maintenance provisions. This provides insurance against theft and vandalism for a 7- year period. The cost being £250 in total.

c) Heartbeat Trust UK - Suggested Defibrillator Locations

Heartbeat Trust UK have suggested that these locations may be worthy of consideration for the placement of defibrillators:

- i) Junction of Heol Pentre Felen & Clasemont Road.
- ii) Bryntywod (Bryntywod Crossroads).

Heartbeat Trust UK had considered an option to place a defibrillator in the Pant Lasau area; however, given its proximity to Morriston Hospital, it was deemed to have little advantage.

Recommended that:

- 1) The update be noted.
- 2) The Council commit to the Heartbeat Trust UK insurance offer for the Defibrillator at the Llangyfelach Church Hall.

19. Training (For Information)

The Clerk referred to the monthly One Voice Wales Remote Training Schedule. Councillors and the Clerk should regularly review their training requirements and were urged to consider training as required. Should a Councillor wish to attend training they should liaise with the Clerk.
